

AGRICULTURE AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT (12 days)

Brazil is a country with a vocation for agribusiness, due to its climate characteristics as well as its geographic diversity. Given these factors, agribusiness is considered the most important sector of the national economy. Historically, tobacco and sugar canes were regarded as an opportunity for agricultural expansion. Families who have worked for generations in food production have switched to monoculture, which has greatly affected the region's biodiversity.

This program focuses on exploring critical issues in sustainable agriculture and development in different regions of Brazil.



Academic and professional excursions with special presentations, such as:

- Stay at IPE (Ecological Research Institute), which is one of the largest environmental NGOs in Brazil.
- Tree planting activity to offset the carbon emission of the program
- Full day with activities at the Fazenda Ambiental Fortaleza, such as yoga, hiking the coffee trail, coffee seminar and cupping, and observation of social projects (breakfast, lunch, and dinner included)
- Visit the Sugar Cane Technology Center
- Visit an orange tree plantation
- Visit a sugar cane mill
- Visit a local organic farm
- Visit the project Urban Agriculture of Curitiba's city hall, which cultivates kitchen gardens in small spaces in the urban area of Curitiba

Cultural excursions and field trips with local bi-lingual guides, such as:

- Guided city tour focused on Curitiba's sustainability plan
- Visit the port of Sao Francisco do Sul
- Boat of 14 islands with a stop to swim

Entrance fees and reservations to museums and sights

Accommodation:

- 1 night at IPE in Nazaré Paulista
- 3 nights at an organic farm in Mococa
- 2 nights at a 4-star hotel in Piracicaba
- 1 night at a 4-star hotel in Curitiba
- 2 nights at a 3-star hotel in São Francisco do Sul

Meals:

- Welcome dinner and orientation session by your on-site coordinator at IPE with a traditional homemade Brazilian meal
- 2 additional group lunches and 2 dinners
- Farewell picnic on the beach of São Francisco do Sul
- Daily breakfast

- Flight from Piracicaba to Curitiba
