Brasília > Belém > Santarém



In the past few years, healthcare has become a matter of global impact. In the international scope, many initiatives related to the topic were created, working to improve the health conditions and to achieve equity in health status of people worldwide. Problems that transcend national borders or have a global political and economic impact are often emphasized.

During the program, students will be able to learn about and experience different initiatives and examine the historical development and components of the Brazilian health system, which is characterized by regional and social inequalities.

Academic and professional excursions with special presentations, such as:

- Lecture at a local university about the Brazilian Health Care System
- Visit the Pan American Health Organization, which is the WHO headquarters in Brazil
- Visit a governmental institution to learn more about the public national health system
- Visit a basic health unit, a place where citizens can seek basic health care
- Visit the headquarters of a mobile emergency care service
- Visit a Brazilian hospital
- Visit a generic pharmaceutical company
- Talk to representatives of "Ciudad Belém" or "Pro Saude"
- Visit the Experimental Study Center Active Rainforest by boat and listen to a presentation about their projects

- Visit the Atodi indigenous community by boat
- Conversation with community health workers
- Visit the Urucureá community to learn about the management of natural fibers and handicraft production
- Visit the Anã community to learn more about their local beekeeping practices, fish farming, and gardening

Cultural excursions and field trips with local bi-lingual guides, such as:

- Guided city tour of Brasília
- Guided city tour of Belém
- Guided city tour of Santarém
- Hike the trail to the Arapiuns River

Entrance fees and reservations to museums and sights

Accommodation:

- 4 nights at a 3-star hotel in Brasília
- 2 nights at a 3-star hotel in Belém
- 2 nights at a 3-star hotel in Santarém
- 2 nights in a boat

Meals:
